I am glad to be back in Bottineau! I want to thank everyone for their warm welcome. The "welcome basket" and quilt were a surprise, but much appreciated gift. Thank you for your thoughtfulness.

I decided to use take this opportunity to share some of my life since I left the United Parish in 1983. I had three years in Australia and it was a wonderful experience. I gave serious thought to staying, but decided I missed my family too much and did not want to be that far away. When I returned from Australia, I was assigned by the Bishop to Miller, South Dakota. I was there three years and while there I met a rancher, George Engelmann, who I married in December, 1990. I eventually got my doctorate degree in counseling from the University of South Dakota. While living at the ranch south of Ree Heights, I worked for 21 years at Community Counseling Services in Huron, SD. My youngest client was 5 years old and my oldest 93. In addition to individual counseling, I did couples and family counseling, conducted child custody evaluations and psychological evaluations. I was surprised by three things: everybody's story was so different, the pain of mental illness is great and poverty too often restricts an individual's opportunities for healing.

During those years, I did considerable pulpit supply. The last three years in South Dakota I served as stated supply for the Presbyterian Church in Wessington, SD. George died in 2013 and in August, 2014, I moved to Sheridan, WY, to be close to my sister, Cheryl, and her daughter, son-in-law and grandkids. Seven years later I moved to Bottineau!

I look forward to engaging in ministry together with each of you as we seek God's direction for our lives and for the United Parish.
